## **MIDTOWN CINEMA TO CONTINUE OPERATING UNDER NEW POWERS & ASSOCIATES MANAGEMENT**

**Harrisburg, PA – The popular Midtown Cinema will continue operating as normal under the new management of midtown developers Powers & Associates, company President John Tierney today announced. The cinema is a popular attraction for midstate independent and art film fans.**

**Tierney said the Midtown Cinema building has now been purchased by Powers & Associates from the Midtown Market District(MMD). Under the terms of the sales agreement, Powers & Associates will now assume all debts and obligations of the building from MMD.**

**“We intend to continue offering the same quality of independent, foreign and art films as the Midtown Cinema has become well-known for,” said Tierney. “It will remain open and operating at its current Reily Street location until the new Campus Square Building is completed across the street, at which time the theater will move into modern new space being created there. The new theater space will have state-of-the-art projection and audio equipment, along with comfortable contemporary seating.”**

**Tierney said Powers & Associates plans to expand activity at the existing Midtown Cinema site by offering morning coffee and light breakfast fare to Midtown workers, students and visitors. The Cinema’s normal operating schedule will remain in effect for moviegoers.**

**“We believe the Midtown Cinema is an important and vital part of Midtown’s overall development strategy, and are committed to not only continuing this role, but substantially expanding it as well,” said Tierney.**
